About the Academy

The academy is an in-depth and rigorous program. It is designed to build excellent Emergency Medical Technician providers. The EMS Academy is also recognized by the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT). In the academy, recruits are subject to classroom lectures, practical exercises and real life training which consists of; Ambulance field training with Manheim Twp. Ambulance and hospital emergency medical department clinical rotations at Ephrata Community Hospital.

Recruits are issued all necessary learning materials as well as a complete uniform (See below for all issued items). Recruits are subjected to rigorous physical work through lifting, lowering, pulling and pushing during practical exercise training.

Admission Requirements

Step 1: Candidates must first fill out an enrollment form and submit it with a \$60.00 check (non-refundable fee) or you may come in to the Manheim Twp. Ambulance Assoc. and pay via credit card.

Step 2: You will receive a phone call and/or email stating when to come in for an interview.

Step 3: After interview, candidates will receive a letter of conditional acceptance to the academy with an uniform sizing date as well as an orientation date.

Step 4: Attend uniform sizing (at this point, candidates are consider recruits and are obligated monetarily for their learning materials and uniforms)

Step 5: Attend orientation (At this point recruits are obligated for full tuition)
